The U.S. Department of Energy is pleased to announce its intention to hold the next Solar Decathlon in the fall of 2005 on the National Mall in Washington, D.C.

The Solar Decathlon is a student competition to design, build, and operate the most attractive and effective, completely solar-powered house. This is a team event designed to test proficiency in a wide range of skills. Architecture and engineering students will work with students from other disciplines to do the designing and building this challenging event requires.

This is an international competition open exclusively to colleges, universities, and other post-secondary educational institutions. Those institutions interested in competing in 2005 should review the Request for Proposals and submit a proposal by April 30, 2003.
