**FedFleet 2010: Showcasing Achievement, Success, and Partnerships**

FedFleet 2010 was a resounding success with 1,613 attendees, 180 exhibitors, and 78 vehicles on display in the exhibit hall. Attendees were given the opportunity to learn from U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) officials who facilitated and presented in 14 workshops. *Overview of E.O. 13514 and Fleet Master Guidance/Handbook*, *Foundation for Success: Building Fuel Infrastructure Partnerships*, and *Hot Topics in Federal Fleets* gave Federal fleet professionals the information and resources to help them meet Federal mandates.

Attendees were also able to attend two extended workshops that brought them together with alternative fuel providers in *The Fuel Up Project: Alternative Fuel Infrastructure Development with Industry Representatives*. These workshops focused on helping attendees improve fleet management and incorporate alternative fuels into fleet programs.

A DOE electric vehicles (EVs) workshop covered the basics of owning and operating EVs. Another workshop aimed to help agencies “get to green” on their Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Transportation Scorecards. This workshop included officials from OMB and provided attendees with the opportunity to speak directly to those who oversee their agency programs. DOE and General Services Administration’s (GSA’s) Federal Acquisition Service (FAS) also taught three workshops on green vehicle acquisitions to help agencies find the right green vehicle to meet their mission.
