



C2C: Clean Energy to Communities

The **Clean Energy to Communities (C2C)** program advances community-led clean energy progress by providing local governments, electric utilities, and community-based organizations with cutting-edge analysis and validation from the U.S. Department of Energy’s national laboratories.

The program offers tailored support across the renewable power, grid, mobility, and buildings sectors that ranges from short term consultation with energy experts to multi-year technical assistance partnerships and direct funding.



In-depth technical partnerships provide cross-sector modeling, analysis, and hardware validation, paired with direct funding, to support teams of electric utilities, local governments, and community-based organizations over 2-3 years.



Peer-learning cohorts convene groups of up to 15 communities regularly over 6 months to learn and exchange strategies and best practices on a common clean energy transition topic.



Expert match pairs communities with national laboratory experts for 40-60 hours of technical assistance to address near-term clean energy challenges and questions.
