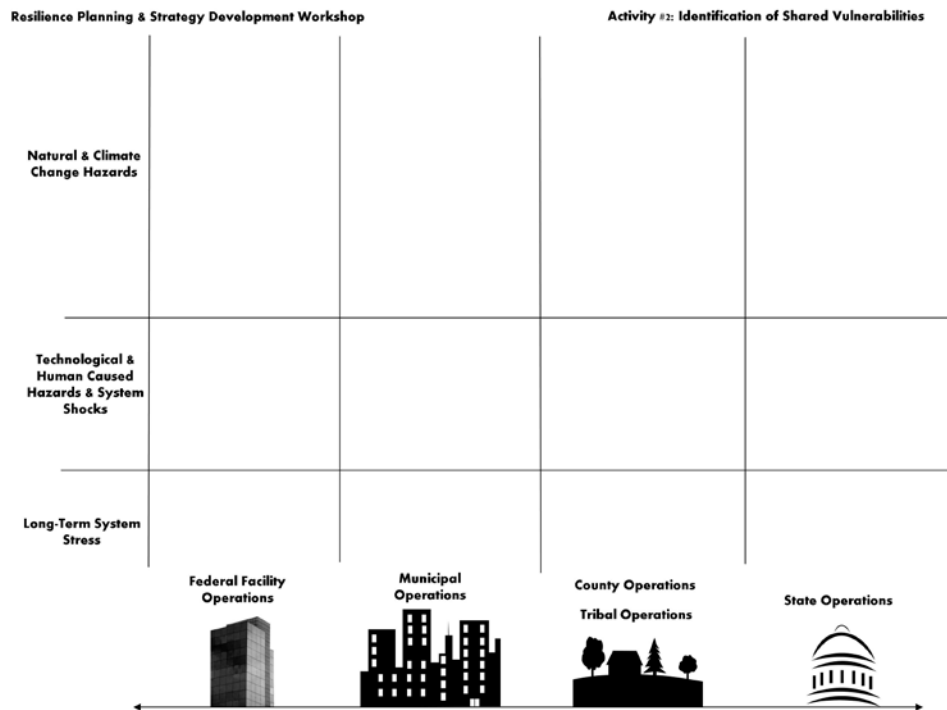
## Activity 2: Identification of Vulnerabilities

### Discussion Questions:

- What are existing common natural threats that jurisdictions share?
- How common are the threats and/or what is the frequency of occurrence?
- What infrastructure systems have been impacted of past natural hazards/system shocks?
- How long did critical infrastructure remain off-line or in a reduced operational state?
- What was the subsequent impact on critical government operations? What was the impact on broader scale community/campus activity?
- How did the compromised infrastructure systems impact multiple jurisdictions and governments?
- Which natural hazards and system shocks are anticipated to increase at the regional level in the future?
